San Joaquin County Historical Museum to appear on Huell Howser's "Road Trip" Feb. 7

The San Joaquin County Historical Museum will be one feature of Public Television personality Huell Howser's "Road Trip" program to be broadcast next week. The Museum preserves and reveals the history of San Joaquin county.

The program will premiere on Feb. 7 on KVIE Channel 6 at 8 p.m. The program will be repeated on Feb. 8 at 2 p.m. and Feb. 9 at 3 a.m. and 4 p.m. For your friends and relatives in Southern California, the premiere will be on KCET in Los Angeles on Feb. 17 at 7 p.m.

Howser came to the Lodi area last October. Over two days, Howser and his cameraman filmed and interviewed numerous individuals in several locations including the museum, Micke Grove Park, Michael David Winery and downtown Lodi.

The "Road Trip" program appears regularly and features different communities throughout the state. The program airs throughout California, Oregon, Nevada, Tennessee and Florida.
