The local history of African-American settlers will be told at the monthly Docent Council meeting on Monday (2/11) at the San Joaquin County Historical Museum in Micke Grove Park south of Lodi.

Marsha Carter, a museum docent and Stockton resident, will present the program she titles "Jeremiah B. Sanderson and the 1868 Stockton Elk Street School for Colored Children." Carter is a retired accountant who has done extensive research at the Oakland Library Archives.
